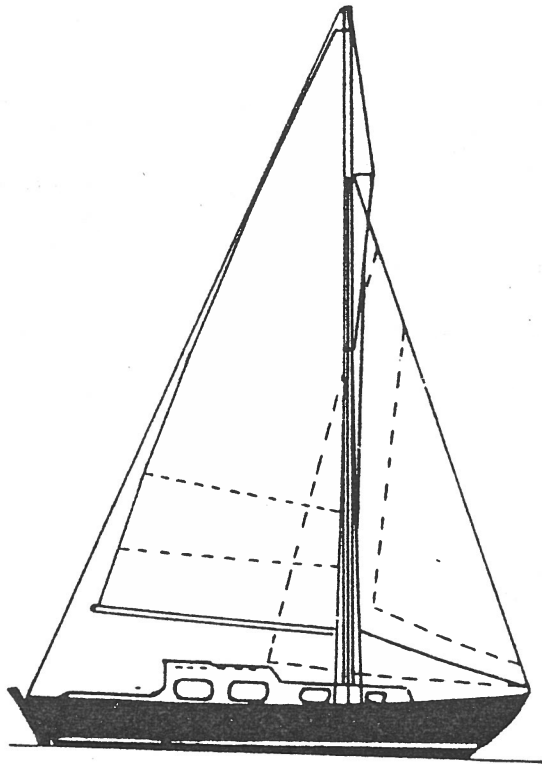

POINTS SYSTEM

Points system for all races: Each yacht obtaining bonus points in the following table will receive the same number of points, with a minimum of 10, as there are starters in the race; plus bonus points as shown in the table below:

<u>Position</u>	<u>2/3Starters</u>	<u>4/5starters</u>	<u>6/7starters</u>	<u>8and over Starters</u>
1st	2	5	9	14
2nd	-	2	5	9
3rd	-	-	2	5
4th	-	-	-	2

The first yacht not to qualify for a bonus will receive two points less than the total of the lowest yacht earning a bonus and yachts below her will each receive one point less than the one above.

Non-finishers will receive no points.

The following races will not count for the points Trophy:

Ladies Race

3rd-10th August Cowes Week

SEASONAL POINTS TROPHY: Best 6 races to count (Mister Jingle Trophy)

COWES WEEK: Cowes Week points are counted seperately, best 5 races count for the PHOENIX TROPHY. Please note there is no SCOD race this year on the final Sunday of Cowes Week ie. 11th August.

The racing programme is split into four separate sections with a closing date for each section. Entries received by the Hon. Secretary after the date will be too late but please enter for as many races as you can manage and if you cannot sail in a race for which you are entered please cancel two weeks before the start, if possible.

ENTRY FEES for the races shown on the fixtures list will be debited to the owners' racing accounts for settlement at the end of the season.

COWES WEEK Separate details and entry forms will be circulated in due course and forms must be returned to the HON.SECRETARY.

Please remember for Cowes Week, entries must be accompanied by the CORRECT ENTRY FEES made out to COWES COMBINED CLUBS.

Late entries will be accepted by the Cowes Combined Clubs only on payment of additional fees.

DINGHIES will be carried on deck (if rubber, fully inflated) in all events marked 'D'.

CHANNEL HANDICAP Races that shall be sailed under the Channel Handicap rating system should the organising club decide that the number of starters are too low to warrant a separate class start are marked with a 'CH'.
