

POINTS SYSTEM

Points system for all races: Each yacht obtaining bonus points in the following table will receive the same number of points, with a minimum of 10, as there are starters in the race; plus bonus points as shown in the table below:

The first yacht not to qualify for a bonus will receive two points less than the total of the lowest yacht earning a bonus and yachts below her will each receive one point less than the one above.

Non-finishers will receive no points.

The following races will not count for the points Trophy: Ladies Race $3rd-10th\ \text{August Cowes Week}$

SEASONAL POINTS TROPHY: Best 6 races to count (Mister Jingle Trophy)

COWES WEEK: Cowes Week points are counted seperately, best 5 races count for the PHOENIX TROPHY. Please note there is no SCOD race this year on the final Sunday of Cowes Week ie. 11th August.

NOTES ON THE 1985 SAILING PROGRAMME

The programme is mainly as in previous years; in addition, however, there will be a rally at Cowes (Sept 7th) before the Ladies Race.

Please remember for Cowes Week, entries must be accompanied by the CORRECT ENTRY FEES made out to COWES COMBINED CLUBS.

Late entries will be accepted by the Cowes Combined Clubs only on payment of additional fees.
